**ACG-Adolescent Children Group.** The children group of age 14 to 18 years, developed in project target villages to ensure the child participation on protection and development of children in those villages.

**ASHA- Accredited Social Health Activist.** Accredited Social Health Activists are community health workers instituted by the government of India's Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) as part of the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM). Selected from the village itself and accountable to it, the ASHA will be trained to work as an interface between the community and the public health system.

**ANM-Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery.** Auxiliary nurse midwife is a village-level female health worker in India who is known as the first contact person between the community and the health services. ANMs are regarded as the grass-roots workers in the health organisation pyramid.

**AKRSP-Aga Khan Rural Support Programme.** It is a non-profit organisation that focuses on supporting marginalised communities' economic development and environmental protection through community-based approaches to natural resource management (NRM) and livelihood enhancement at the village level.

**AWW-Anganwadi Worker.** Female selected from the village under Integrated Child Development Scheme (ICDS) of Women and Child Development Department to ensure the nutritional services to pregnant and lactating women, adolescent girls and children below 6 years.

**BCPU-Block Child Protection Unit.** The block level child protection unit developed under Integrated Child Protection Scheme.

**BEO-Block Education Officer.**Block Education Officer is responsible for overall administrative support the schools and officials under the defined region

**BAC- Block Academic Coordinator**

**BRC-Block Resource Coordinator.**

**Block Resource Centres (BRCs)and Cluster Resource Centres (CRCs)** were established in each **block** of every district under SarvaShikshaAbhiyan (SSA) to conduct in-service teacher training and to provide academic support to teachers and schools on a regular basis as well as to help in community mobilization activities.

**CBO-Community Based Organisation**

**CEDMAP- Centre for Entrepreneurship Development Madhya Pradesh.** The agency developed for the promotion and development of enterprise through training / research / publication etc.

**CG-Children Group**

**CL Act-Child Labour Act.**The central legislature of India had promulgated a legislation Child and Adolescent Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 to regulate the child labour practices in India. The central legislature has made substantial changes in the provisions of the CL Act in the year 2016 and the said amendments have been made effective from July 30, 2016

**CPC-Child Protection Committee.** Child Protection Committees are developed under integrated child protection scheme and have a key role to play in the continuous improvement of child protection policy and practice

**CPO-Child Protection Officer.**They are Child welfare officers, generally social workers who deal specifically with assessing the care of minors. Employed primarily through state or local government agencies, they may be involved in investigations into abuse, neglect or unlawful activities.

**CWC-Child Welfare Committee.**Body constituted by the State Government under the Juvenile Justice Act to discharge all the responsibilities in relation to children in need of care and protection.

**DCPU-District Child Protection Unit.** The district level unit developed under integrated child protection scheme to ensure the protection of each child in the district.

**DPC- District Programme Coordinator**

**DEO-District Educational Officer.**Responsible for managingthe District Education Office through monitoring and supervision of staff to ensure that the objectives of the District are met.

**DIET-District Institution for Education of Teachers.**An academic and intellectual body at the district level designed to offer all the support required to improve the standard of primary education under the SarvaShikshaAbhiyan scheme. The main functions of DIET are- training, resource support, research and monitoring, evaluation, coordination with schools.

**DPM-District Programme Manager**

**DWEO- District Women Empowerment Officer.**The officer appointed in Women and Child Development Department to ensure the protection and empowerment of women in the district. Under integrated child protection scheme in Madhya Pradesh the officer is also in charge of the child protection in the district.

**ICPS-Integrated Child Protection Scheme.**Integrated Child Protection Scheme is based on the principles of 'protection of child rights' and 'best interests of the child' and aims to institutionalize services for emergency outreach, family and community based care, counselling and support. ICPS sensitizes functionaries in the system towards child protection, and raises public awareness. It seeks to put in place both preventive and curative mechanisms for a child needing protection from exploitation, harassment, health hazards, etc. The model adopts government-civil society partnership to ensure child protection and create a safe and healthy environment for the children of India.

**JJ Act-Juvenile Justice Act.**Law relating to juveniles in conflict with law, and children in need of care and protection by providing proper care, protection and treatment by catering to their developmental needs, by adopting child friendly approach in adjudication and disposition.

**JJB-Juvenile Justice board.** Board formed under JJ Act and shall consist of a Metropolitan Magistrate or a Judicial Magistrate of the first class, as the case may be, and two social workers of whom at least one shall be a woman, forming a Bench and every such Bench shall have the powers conferred by the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), on a Metropolitan Magistrate or, as the case may be, a Judicial Magistrate of the first class and the Magistrate on the Board shall be designated as the principal Magistrate.

**KVK-KrishiVikas Kendra.** Project initiated for enhancement of Indian Farmers and transformation of Rural India. It is providing quality of services and products which develop the agriculture sector in the country.

**MDM- Mid day meal.** The Midday Meal Scheme is a school meal programme of the Government of India designed to improve the nutritional status of school-age children nationwide. The programme supplies free lunches on working days for children in primary and upper primary classes in government, government aided, local body, Education Guarantee Scheme, and alternate innovative education centres, *Madarsa* and *Maqtabs* supported under SarvaShikshaAbhiyan, and National Child Labour Project schools run by the ministry of labour.

**MPJAP- Madhya Pradesh Jan AbhiyanParishad.** Formed by Madhya Pradesh government to coordinate and strengthen the grass NGOs for the rural development.

**NCLP-National Child Labour Project.** Central Government Scheme for the rehabilitation of child labour. The Scheme seeks to adopt a sequential approach with focus on rehabilitation of children working in hazardous occupations & processes in the first instance.

**NRLM- National Rural Livelihood Mission(Aajeevika).** National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) was launched by the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Government of India in June 2011. Aided in part through investment support by the World Bank, the Mission aims at creating efficient and effective institutional platforms of the rural poor, enabling them to increase household income through sustainable livelihood enhancements and improved access to financial services.

**PRI-Panchayat Raj Institutions.** Panchayati Raj is a system of governance in which gram panchayats are the basic units of administration. It has 3 levels: village, block and district. Through the Panchayat Raj Institutions, the government aims to attain decentralised & participatory local self-government.

**SHG-Self Help Group.** Self-Help Group (SHG) is a small voluntary association of poor people, preferably from the same socio-economic background. They come together for the purpose of solving their common problems through self-help and mutual help. The SHG promotes small savings among its members. The savings are kept with a bank. This common fund is in the name of the SHG. SHG is a group formed by the community, which has specific number of members like 15 or 20. Usually, the number of members in one SHG does not exceed twenty. In such a group the poorest would come together for emergency, disaster, social reasons, economic support to each other, have ease of conversation, social interaction and economic interactions.

**RSK-RajyaSikshaKendre.** It is the state project office of SarvaSikshaAbhiyan, SCERT and adult education which covers the administration, finance and skill build up and management of all primary and upper primary schools in the state and also the text book publications for those schools.

**RTE Act-Right to Education Act.** Is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted on 4 August 2009, which describes the modalities of the importance of free and compulsory education for children between 6 and 14 in India under Article 21a of the Indian Constitution.

**SDM-Sub Divisional Magistrate.** A **Sub-Divisional Magistrate** is a title sometimes given to the head official of a district subdivision, an administrative officer that is sometimes below the level of district, depending on a country's government structure. Each district is divided into tehsil. It is empowered by tax inspector, collector magistrate. All subdivision (tehsil) is under the charge of SDM (Sub Divisional Magistrate).

**SMC-School Management Committee.** Under the RTE Act school management committee is the basic unit of a decentralized model of governance. It consists of parents and teacher as well as management to monitor admission process and daily activities of the school.

**SHG-Self Help Group.** Village-based financial intermediary committee usually composed of 10–20 local women or men.

**SCG-School Children Groups.** The children group of age 10 to 14 years, developed in project target school to ensure the child participation on protection and development of children in those schools.

**SJPU-Special Juvenile Police Unit.** A unit of the police force of a State designated for handling of juveniles or children under section 63 of Juvenile Justice Act of India.

**WCDD-Women and Child Development Department.** The Department of Women and Child Development, Government of India, came into existence as a separate ministry with effect from 30th January, 2006, earlier since 1985 it was a department under the Ministry of Human Resources Development. The Ministry was constituted with prime intention to address gaps in state action for women and children for promoting inter-ministerial and inter-sectoral convergence to create gender equitable and child-centred legislation, policies and programmes.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In this Period MAHATMA GANDHI SEVA ASHRAM Collected Base line survey Data from programme area to know the Situation of Child engaged in Economical activity or engaged cotton farms and How much children are out of school and How much Children engage in labour activity more than 2 hours in their home. We have visited 10192 House in both Kukshi and Manawar Block and found 2992 Children are out of school and 4000 Children irregular in School. We also conducted 9 School Management committee and covered 38 MS and PS in Both the Block. 45 nos of Mobilization and awareness raised Activity Conducted through NUKAD NATKA, RALLY, and Community meeting in this Period 2450 both male and female , 907 Children's were directly participated . 15 nos of stakeholder meeting conducted has done by MGSA team for networking , linkage and sensitised about the child rights issues at village level and are adequately aware on Child Protection. Sensitization meetings were conducted with parents, PRIs, SHG leaders, line departments , and community regarding the school education and prevention of child labour in the villages. 73 Parents Meeting conducted in this period and 1587 parents Directly participate in this meeting .and 28 nos of SHG leaders also involved in this process. 2 nos of Block level Mahapanchayat conducted Kukshi and Manawar for raised their Issues in front of Different stakeholders. 625 nos of Youths, Children's Community , Parents , School children's were participated . conducted 26 nos of Child protection Committee Training for provide training on child protection, child rights, child labour - issue, monitoring, prevention & response. Special events were conducted in the villages during National and international day against child labour on 30<sup>th</sup> April and 12<sup>th</sup> June for mass sensitization and mobilization against child labour and 26<sup>th</sup> January celebrated through extra curricular activity in Schools for encouraging children's .conducted Supporting/Facilitating CPCs and CGs in performing their role and conduct monthly meetings with them to understand the progress made, challenges faced and design risk mitigation strategies In this period. In this process 379 Children's and 1145 nos of community and CPC member were involved. Conducted awareness drives/meetings through Audio , Distribution of Leaflets in all the 35 Programme area to make adolescents aware on possible options of alternate employment and families receive information on government social welfare schemes. In this process 2483 youth and 4417 Community directly participate and got information from us. During Awareness drive we have provided pamphlets of Different govt. Schemes and institution contact numbers and Address. In this period conducted 30 nos of School Children Group training programme in cluster level and covered 56 backward school from both the block for raise voice of children for the protection of their right . we also organised Media meeting for raise the child labour and child protection issues. In this process 13 nos of different media reporter were participated. In this period we have provided skill training to 158 youth on Computer and Tailoring .out of 158 youth 20 Girls from Manawar and 6 Girls From kukshi After getting Skill training they Established their Tailoring shop in their respective Villages and self employed .3 nos of Youth has got job in Private shop one from Manawar and one from Kukhsi. Conducted 2 nos of Life Skill training for Adolsence in Kukshi and Manawar. 70 Youth both Girls and Boys were participated.

In this programme 99 women leader has trained as a women champions who will promote gender equality and equal wages, produce cotton without involvement of child labour. In this meeting 206 SHG members were participated.
- ❖ **Sensitization Meetings with parents**: 73 nos of Parents meeting conducted in both the Block in this period . Objective of the Meeting was to identifying drop out children, s who are working in child labour activity . To Mobilize the parents and children's about child education and Child rights . Interaction and discussion with parents about their problems and needs. Finally Team identified and analysis their issues and problems then make a plan for creating awareness on Child education and child protection programme. in this programme 1668 Parents were participated. Male- 765 & 903 Female were participated.
- ❖ **Meeting with School Children Group** : Conducted 30 nos School children Groups meeting in both the block covered 56 backward school .Objective was to SCG for the children identified and analysis their issues and raise their voice for their protection , School children group will find who not come school last 2-3 day after that they visit children's home and meet with children and parents and find reason for the children's absents and told to their teacher's..another objective was to create awareness on Child protection and education and. Total 270 Girls and 180 boys were participated .
- ❖ **Meeting with adolescents/young adults** : 24 nos adolescents meeting conducted in this period. Objective of the Meeting was identify and analysis the Issue related to children I.e Child labour , Child marriage about Unemployment and identified the youth for providing Skill Training. Another objective was to Mobilize the Community for creating awareness on Education and Raise their Voice against Child labour . Adolescent Group find any issue related to children, youth after that discuss with parents and Project team what they do for that children/youth In this process 287 Youth were participated .boys - 106 and Girls- 181



- ❖ **Supporting/Facilitating CPCs and CGs in performing their role and conduct monthly meetings** : 49 nos Supporting/Facilitating CPCs and CGs in performing their role and conduct monthly meetings conducted in this period in Manawar and Kukshi . Objective of the meeting was conducted Supporting/Facilitating CPCs and CGs in performing their role and conduct monthly meetings with them to understand the progress made, challenges faced and design risk mitigation strategies and Creating awareness on Child protection committee and children Groups role among the Community. In this process 379 Children's and 1145 nos of community and CPC member were involved.

## Training and Capacity Building

- ❖ **School Management Training** : 9 School Management committee and covered 38 MS and PS in Both the Block. School Management Training objective of the training programme was to provide knowledge about Role and Responsibility of SMC and aware about Different Govt Schemes which related in Education. To analyze the impact of teacher training and SMC .To inform the stakeholder about child friendly education. To make aware of SSR (School Sector Reform) and Continue Assessment System (CAS). To discuss the role and responsibilities of SMC. To find out the ways to improve school management .To make annual plan for school improvement and to divide the responsibilities .To discuss different Govt Schemes regarding Education. In this programme 245 male and 115 female were participated.
- ❖ **CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE TRAINING** : Conducted 66 nos of Child protection committee training in both the Block. Objective of the Programme was To provide knowledge to the CPCs and CGS on specific issues - child protection, child rights, child labour - issue, monitoring, prevention & response on Child protection and Child education in kukshi and Manawar. In this programme 990 participants were participated. Male 345 and 415 Female and 230 Boys and girls .
- ❖ **LIFE SKILLS TRAINING ON ADOLSCENCE** : 2 nos life skills for adolescents/young adults conducted in this Month 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> in Kukshi and 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> in manawar. Objective of the Training was provide training to the youth on Life skills are abilities for adaptive and positive behavior, Training has given by Mr Pradeep Nair and he Described in this way, skills that can be said to be life skills are innumerable, and the nature and definition of life skills are likely to differ across cultures and settings. However, analysis of the life skills field suggests that there is a core set of skills that are at the heartof skills-based initiatives for the promotion of the health and well-being of children andadolescents. These are listed below:

**VOCATIONAL TRAINING TO THE YOUTH : 6** nos of Skill training Sessions on Tailoring and Computer conducted in this report reporting period. 63 Youth has completed Tailoring and Computer training. 49 Youth in Tailoring Trade and 14 youth from Computer trade has completed their traing. In this Period 29 youth has self employed.

## Government linkage

Better working relationship has been established with education and women and child department, CWC, SJPU, JJB, Labour Dept., at district and block levels. At the same time the administrative support at block level has been gained during this period. 3 WhatsApp groups has been developed in Block and District level in which the block level and cluster level officials are members. This group discuss the day to day operational issues of schools and education of underprivileged children. Jointly with education department executed school enrollment drives at village level. At the same time with District women empowerment officer (DWEO) (who is also the district head of child protection) sharing the formed 35 CPCs at village level and actions for the prevention of child labours and other issues related to children continuing.

Objective was to enhance the knowledge of common people on the PDS item and other necessary information with their rights for proper implementation of the govt. programme on Education and Child protection. .& Conducted awareness drives/meetings through Audio , Distribution of Leaflets in all the 35 Programme area to make adolescents aware on possible options of alternate employment and families receive information on government social welfare schemes. In this process 2483 youth and 4417 Community directly participate and got information from us Developed broachers containing the messages for main stream education and prevention child labour and distributed to the community at village level. In this period 150 slogan painting and 14 Wall writing on Child labor and Child education both Village and School in all 35 respective villages for creation awareness on Education and protection.

## Meetings with officials at block and district level

15 nos Block level meeting conducted in Kukshi and Manawar Blocks with block administration and education department. In addition to the orientation about the project and its outcomes they were also briefed about the situation of education at schools in the villages. The significance of regular tracking of the attendance of the children and quality education in class rooms were shared with them. The BEO of Kukshi asked to prepare monthly plan together with education department regarding the monitoring of quality education and innovative programmes at village level to ensure the regularity of children in schools. In the programme block academic coordinator (BAC), block resource coordinator (BRC), gender officer and school headmaster and teachers participated along with project team.

Another thing is CPC identified 2 children from Bdgrye they were engaged in labour activity. After CPC advocacy BRC has taken decisions Ganga will study at Kasturba Ashram .

## Media issue highlights and action

Leading Patrika news Paper has taken Child labour issue in Media. Specially Ganga and Rameswar , badgyre Case. After Media Highlighted Panchayat has made her Samgra ID and given pensions 800/- per month to her family and also her family selected for PMAY shelter. CEO , MLA has visited Gangas home and assured they will support as soon as possible.

## Actions by different groups at village and block level and its impact

### With schools

In this period Village level Group has taken several action in their Village. The following action has taken by Groups

- School children group of Badgyre identified the Issues on water and separate Toilet and raised their issues in front of B RC and PHED dept. And its impact was within one month Govt. Has provided water and build separate Toilet.
- CPC identified Child labour and Raised their issues in front of Block and District stakeholder . impact was Ganga will take fostercare and Rameswar will study at Children's home .Silkua
- ACG Kasthali identified two child labour who are working in ICE kendy . They rescued through child line and linked with school.
- ACG of all 35 villages they have been visiting door to door and creating awareness on child labour and mobilised to those parents who are not sending school to their children.
- Its impact are 216 Children are free from child labour in this period.
- SCGs has been visiting every Sunday in their respective villages fwho are not coming to school for contact them and mobilise them for coming to school in regular

- Its Impact is Children attendance has increased
- Block level its impact is BRC has recognised the SCG and personally visited to SCG inspired them for continuing this strategy.
- SHG members also involved this process and motivated those parents who are not sending their children for child labour.

when save the children came to my village I was unaware of the Project objective and was reluctant to go to attend children’s Group meeting but one of a neighbour friend Vishal told Me this NGO is working for Children who are interested for vocational Training for self employment they will give opportunity for Training. At first I joined as a Member of BISHNU youth Group in the Month of August 2017 then I attend several life skill training programme and I have been participating several activity which was conducted by MGSA regarding Child education and protection .under Trapped in cotton project. Main objective of the Project was to create awareness among those parents who are engaging their children in labour activity. And also create awareness among those children who are stopped their education. Then me and Group Member of BISHNU youth group started Door Visit of those Family who are engaging their children for child labour . After several time visiting few Parents they did not agreed to send their children to school for education. Our Village has many children they have been working in their farm they did not go to school in regular . one day I identified 2 child labor who are between 10-14 years old . one is Ajay S/O-Rakesh , Raju S/o- Vijay . They have been working in HINA ICE CREAM KNENDY, MANAWAR since April. Vishal and Mayur went to HINA ice cream factory on 16<sup>th</sup> May and discussion with Factory owner about child labor. But he did not respond them and engaging them for ICE Craem Making work. Then I called to Child line India on



30<sup>th</sup> May 2018. Child line Team and manawar Police came at 1pm to Hina Ice cream kandy factory and rescue to both Ajay and Vijay and handed over to their family.

Now both the children agreed they will continue their education in the current session . Their parents also agreed they will not engage any labour activity in future. They freed their children from child labour .

Its a great achievement of me in life. I have changed 2 children life after joined BISHMU YOUTH Group.

Miss .Komal (18Yrs) used to reside in this village named as,Patelpura BADGYAR “1” with his family means Father, Mother 02nos of brother.Sanjay -19 , and Jiten-21 . Komal’s uncle has adopted to Jiten since his childhood .and 1 younger brother going to school for study . Her father name is omkar he is 48 years old, andHer mother names is Budibai she is 40 years old.Here basically the Badgyarvillage is SC/ST populated village and the total household is 555nos (ST HHs – 423nos& SC36 HHs – 275nos.OBCHH -)

Miss Komal belongs to ST&landless household in the village and also he used to work as daily labour for his family’s livelihoods.Her income source is only depends Agriculture and wages and earned a marginal amount which is not sufficient to manage the day to day requirement of his family.Komal did not continue her study after 10 thclass,becauseher family condition was not good,shedoes’nt have money for continue her education.so She used to go agriculture field with her parents. For doing laboractivity . She use to go work 20-25days every month in her farm and also others farm she use to get 1000-1500 per month from labor work that she use to suffer various type of desis that is health sknindesis stomach problem, mensuration problem, still she use to engage labour activity.When she does’nt have any work she use to go Field with Goat and cow for grazing . They are also used to collect NTFPs
